Rule Book Correction (03/20/09)

Page 105, Paragraphs 4, 5, and 6

Paragraph #4: Placing for third in the pools: When two wrestlers go out in the same round and are considered for third place the criteria is as follows:

1. Their match if previously wrestled.
2. If they have not wrestled, their total classification points for the competition.
3. If the points are tied they will have a special bout to determine third place.

The wrestler with two defeats who advances in this manner does not wrestle in the round robin, but automatically places third.

Paragraph #5: For places below third in the group, each wrestler is ranked by the round in which he/she was eliminated, then the following criteria against the others they are being compared with:

1. Their match if previously wrestled.
2. If they have not wrestled, their total classification points for the competition.
3. If the points are tied they will have a special bout to determine placing.

Paragraph #6: Wrestlers eliminated in round prior to the round robin round are ranked by these criteria against the others they are being compared with:

1. Their match if previously wrestled.
2. If they have not wrestled, their total classification points for the competition.
3. If the points are tied they will have a special bout to determine placing for any tangible award.
4. If tangible awards are not a consideration then the wrestlers can be placed according to the criteria on page #107.
